



Vellum & More Adhesive Perfect Vellum

With Scotch® Vellum & More Adhesive you can stick your vellum to your scrapbook page without leaving any visible signs of adhesive on your vellum. This is so difficult to do with most scrapbooking adhesives, that many scrapbookers use brads instead. Now you can have perfect looking vellum using adhesive. For best results you'll need your can of Scotch® Vellum & More Adhesive, vellum, a small amount of protective paper and, if available, a pair of tweezers. For perfect looking vellum, prepare a small area of your workspace with some protective paper and follow the steps below.



1) After shaking can, hold 12 inches from vellum and spray to apply even coating of adhesive on vellum.



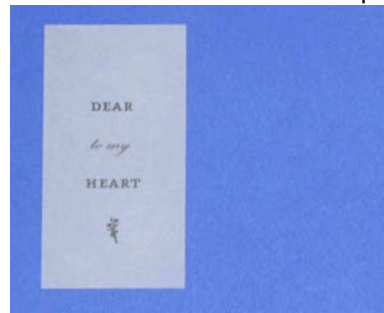
2) Wait for approximately 1 minute or until adhesive is dry before sticking vellum to scrapbook page.



3) Separate coated vellum from protective paper by pushing tweezers between vellum and protective paper.



4) Carefully pick up vellum by edges taking care not to touch the adhesive surface with your fingers.



5) Position vellum on scrapbook page and gently smooth the vellum into place from the center to the edges of the vellum. Use the soft side of your hand or fingers for best results.

- Start with small samples of vellum to perfect your technique and handling skills.
- For even better results, use a very light repositionable coat of adhesive on the protective paper before coating your vellum. This will hold your vellum in place when you spray it with adhesive and won't transfer to the vellum (see Special Techniques Tip Sheet).
- Remove any tacky overspray or finger prints from the front of your vellum with a gum rubber eraser after you've bonded the vellum to your scrapbooking page. Be careful, fingerprints on the adhesive side can't be removed!! Remember to have FUN and be CREATIVE!!
